Discover the crystal-clear waters, pristine beaches, and vibrant marine life of the Bahamas.

The archipelago known as The Bahamas, comprising more than 700 islands and cays, extends across 100,000 square miles of radiant blue waters, forming a gentle east-to-west curve just 50 miles off the Florida Coast.

Most are deserted cays with unspoiled reefs, shallow fishing waters, and a plethora of dive sites, while only a few are inhabited.

DAY 1 | HOPE TOWN ABACO

Begin your Bahamas yacht charter with a visit to the main village on the island of Elbow Cay, Hope Town, which is clearly the most scenic settlement in the Bahamas.

You can discover the Wyannie Malone Museum, see the famous lighthouse with candy stripes, and stroll through the narrow streets of this pastel-colored city.

Motorized vehicles are restricted, so the streets are quiet and a pleasure to walk.



PARADISE ISLAND NASSAU | DAY 2



On the second day, set your course to the capital of the Bahamas - Nassau Paradise Island, where the ease of the tropics meets the big city.

Here, beautiful beaches are just the beginning. Venture beyond them and discover an island humming with history, art, nightlife, and culture.

In the evening you can dine at the famous Café Matisse, a popular local venue with its beautiful open-air courtyard resembling the gardens of magnificent Bahamian villas.

Move away from the city center to admire the most beautiful beaches such as Love Beach or Cable Beach, popular with visitors.

DAY 3

WARDERICK WELLS CAY

On the 3rd day, navigate to Warderick Wells, a magical place loved by all watersports' fans.

This island is ideal for snorkeling, scuba diving in crystal-clear waters. Underneath the surface are some spectacular displays of coral reefs. Under the continued protection of the Land and Sea Park, the coral displays are bountiful and densely populated by local wildlife.



Even a quick trip through the reefs will introduce you to hundreds of brightly colored fish, lobsters, and maybe even turtles.

After lunch onboard, head ashore to explore some of the beautiful hiking trails.

STANIEL CAY

DAY 4



Cruise to Staniel Cay Island- a small island only inhabited by a little over 100 residents. This location is one of the most outstanding snorkeling places of the entire Bahamas: take a small boat to reach these caves and dive into the beautiful seabed to observe exotic marine life and many coral reefs.

You can even swim with a lagoon full of reef sharks at Compass Cay.

It is unknown exactly how many reef sharks are swimming in these waters but you don't have to worry, they are non-aggressive.

Don't miss a chance to visit the Grotto Thunderbolt Caves, named after the famous James Bond movie "Thunderball", which was actually shot there.

DAY 5 | MAJOR'S SPOT

In the morning, go to the Pig island in Major's spot - one of the most popular attractions in the Bahamas.

The island is named after the pigs who often swim on this uninhabited island of white sand beaches.

They love the remains of the Yacht Club kitchen so they will, for sure, come to your boat to welcome you! We are sure you haven't seen this before!



LONG ISLAND

DAY 6



After breakfast onboard, cruise to the Long Island. Brilliant coral reefs, pristine flats, and serene beaches make Long Island a haven for fishing, diving, and boating.

Take a dip in one of the deepest blue holes in the world at Dean's Blue Hole, culminating at 203 meters depth.

In the afternoon, meet Docky Smith, the only and best fisherman in Long Island for a quick lesson in fishing for bonefish. Give yourself a lunch break at the Lumina Point Resort and Spa Hotel.

DAY 7

ATLANTIS
NASSAU

End your trip in Atlantis, the 'Vegas-by-the-sea,' which boasts a large casino, great restaurants, clubs, and amazing aquariums. Don't miss the opportunity to experience some of the most spectacular waterslides in the world!

One of the largest water-themed attractions globally is situated here — the 141-acre waterscape of Aquaventure. It features 18 thrilling water slides and a mile-long river ride that incorporates waves, rapids, tunnels, and much more.

Explore numerous restaurants and bars during your visit. Indulge in the delicious dishes at the famous gourmet Café Martinique restaurant, and make sure to include a visit to Nobu — a place that should not be missed.



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
