


DAY 1-2 CALVI

DAY 6-7 BONIFACIO

In all seasons, it offers a unique collection of historic monuments, more than 20 fine-sandy beaches, and an exceptional collection of rare countryside both on land and at sea.






You can take a hike on a trail carved into the cliff for outstanding views out to the sea or prefer to stay cool and visit the historical monuments located in town.

LAVEZZI ISLANDS DAY 8

These Islands are a natural reserve. Being one of the two Corsican marine reserves, Lavezzi islands are bathed in a turquoise and emerald sea, whose color varies according to the light.



Once in the water, the transparency is really surprising, probably the clearest water in Corsica. The beaches are numerous and truly magnificent. This is the ideal place to spend a lazy day enjoying the Mediterranean sun.
