Croatia will fascinate everyone looking for new experiences: crystal clear blue water, perfect spots for various water sports, colorful picturesque villages, natural parks, UNESCO-protected historic cities, dramatic waterfalls, and vibrant nightlife.

DAY 1 | DUBROVNIK



Dubrovnik is a beautiful location to start or end your charter. Meet your yacht in the port of Dubrovnik near the historic old town. The city is home to top restaurants and designer shops and also beautiful and well-preserved monuments.

Explore the city's white limestone streets, baroque buildings, and ancient city walls.

If you are a "Game of Thrones" fan, don't miss the chance to take a tour of the locations featured in the TV series. Come back on board for a delicious lunch prepared by your private Chef. In the afternoon, visit the stunning Botanical gardens and monastery on the uninhabited island of Lokrum.



MLJET

DAY 2

Cruise to Mljet. This isolated and untouched island is well known for its rich cultural heritage (among which is an impressive 12th-century Benedictine monastery) and unique National park where you can explore local flora and fauna and enjoy the pristine beauty of nature. National Park Mljet stretches over one third of the island of the same name and is one of the most beautiful Adriatic gems, a green oasis whose meditative energy cannot be missed.

If you want to avoid the crowds, best is to anchor in the Gonoturska bay, which overlooks the open sea and is often chosen by larger yachts when their owners want to spend a romantic night at anchor.



DAY 3

KORCULA



After a breakfast onboard, visit Korcula and get lost in its narrow charming streets with a mix of Gothic and Renaissance buildings. Korcula or "Little Dubrovnik", in addition to being the birthplace of Marco Polo, is considered one of the most protected medieval cities in the world.

Take a chance to try the local cuisine and enjoy the gorgeous view from Filippi restaurant. Visit local wineries and taste one of the best Adriatic wines produced here.



VIS & BISEVO ISLANDS

DAY 4

Visit Vis and Bisevo islands. The island of Vis is beloved among locals and international yachts alike. Made famous by "Mamma Mia! Here We Go Again", filmed on its shores, the island has made it to the UNESCO geo-parks list. After a mesmerizing Vis with its sea fares, fishermen, and beautiful natural surroundings, don't miss the chance to explore the unique Blue Cave on Bisevo (the symbol of the tiny island) with its numerous entrances both above and below sea level.



When the sea is calm, the light paints the interior of the cave in blue and everything above the water line, in silver. Come back on board to enjoy sunset cocktails and a delicious dinner from your Chef.

DAY 5 | HVAR

Cruise to Hvar - the longest Adriatic island, holding the record for the number of sunny days per year.

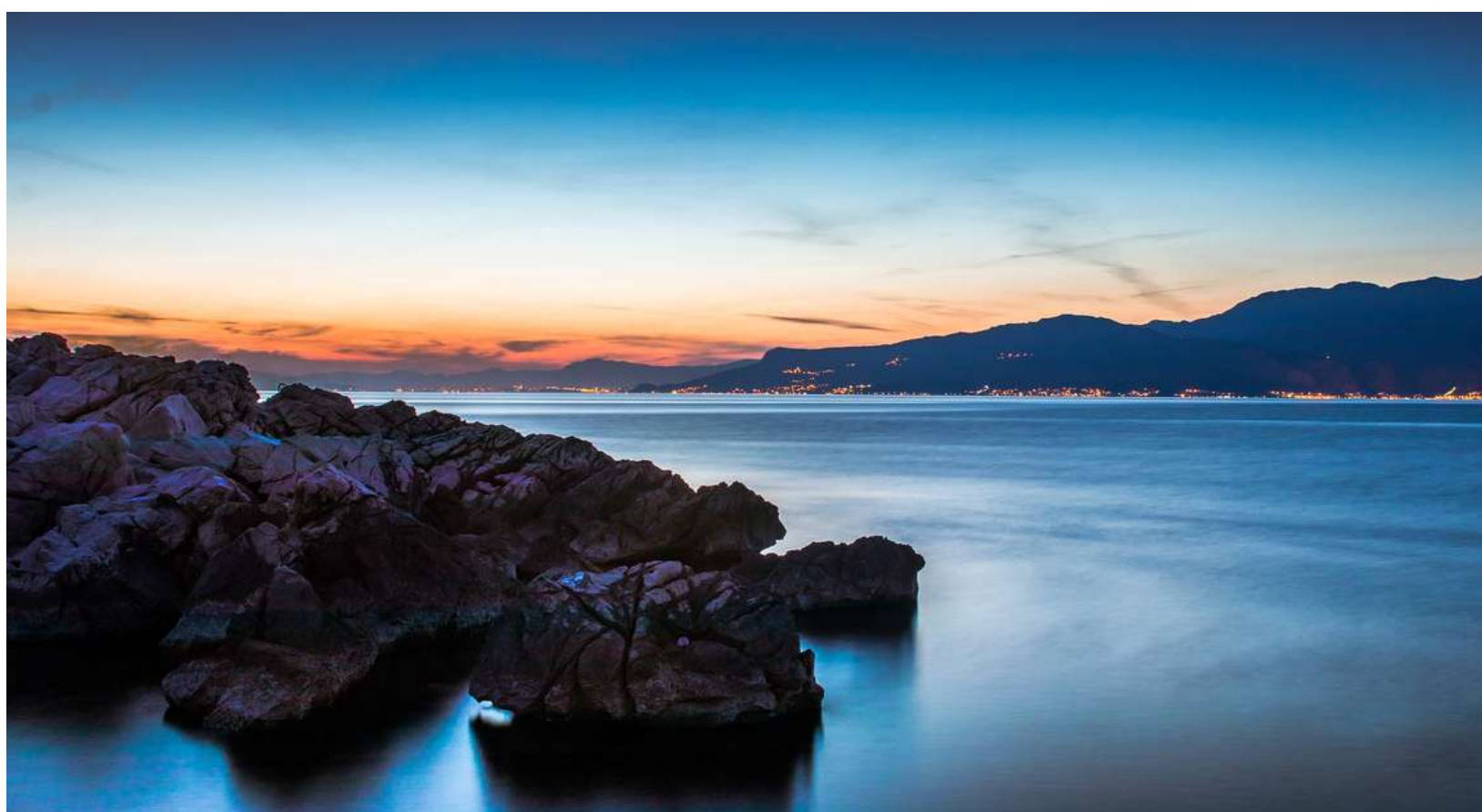

DAY 6



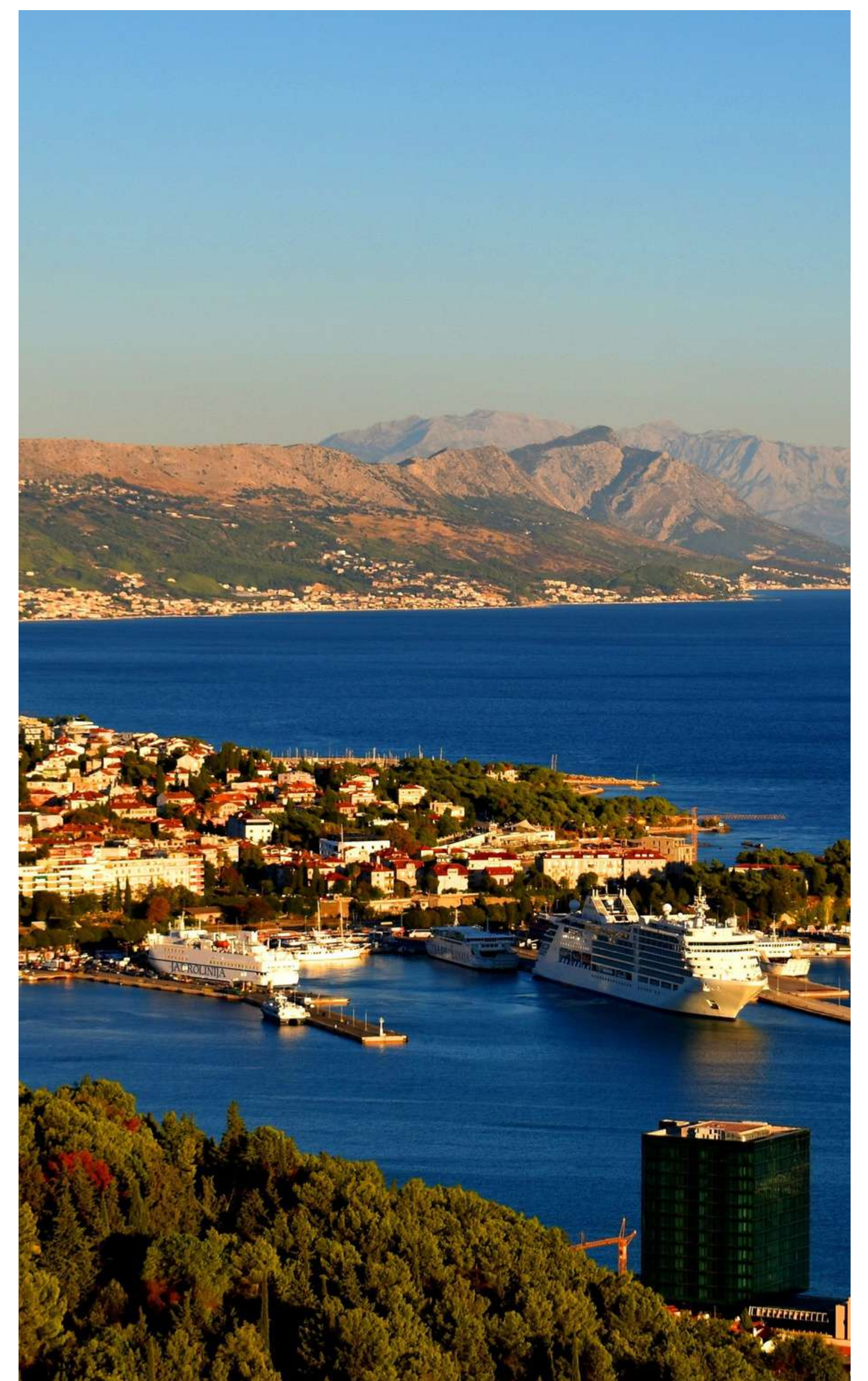
Explore the island of Brac with its bays covered with forests of cypress trees and magic sandy beaches. This island is 40 km long and 12 km wide, it is one of the largest in Central Dalmatia. Its vegetation is abundant, and its coves and secret harbors are numerous.

Don't miss Zlatni rat in Bol beach, which is included on the list of the 10 most beautiful beaches in the world. Covered with fine sand, it has a triangular shape with a prominent peak in the sea, the direction of which depends on the direction of the current.



DAY 7 | SPLIT

Rest on the yacht, sunbathing on the deck and enjoying stunning surroundings with a glass of chilled champagne. Cruise to Split. Built in and around the extravagant palace of a 4th-century Roman emperor, the city of Split boasts a splendid medieval history as well as exceptional beauty spots for you to explore.



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
