DAY 1 | GOCEK

Gocek is a small village in an idyllic setting, located in the corner of a well-protected bay with pine-covered hills looking out over the Twelve Islands and offering one of the most picturesque sceneries in Turkey.

OLUDENIZ GEMILER

DAY 2



After breakfast, cruise to Oludeniz, also known as the Blue Lagoon, a small village and beach resort located on the southwestern Turquoise coast. One of the most photographed beaches on the Mediterranean and ranked one of the top beaches in the world, Oludeniz is known for its pebbled shores and glistening aquamarine waters.

Be sure to stop at Oludeniz for paragliding over its brilliant blue lagoon and emerald hills.

Nearby is Gemiler Island, located just off the coast of Turkey near the city of Fethiye. Anchor at its crescent-shaped bay and explore the ruins of several churches built between the 4th and 6th Centuries AD. Archeologists believe this is where the original tomb of St. Nicholas was located.

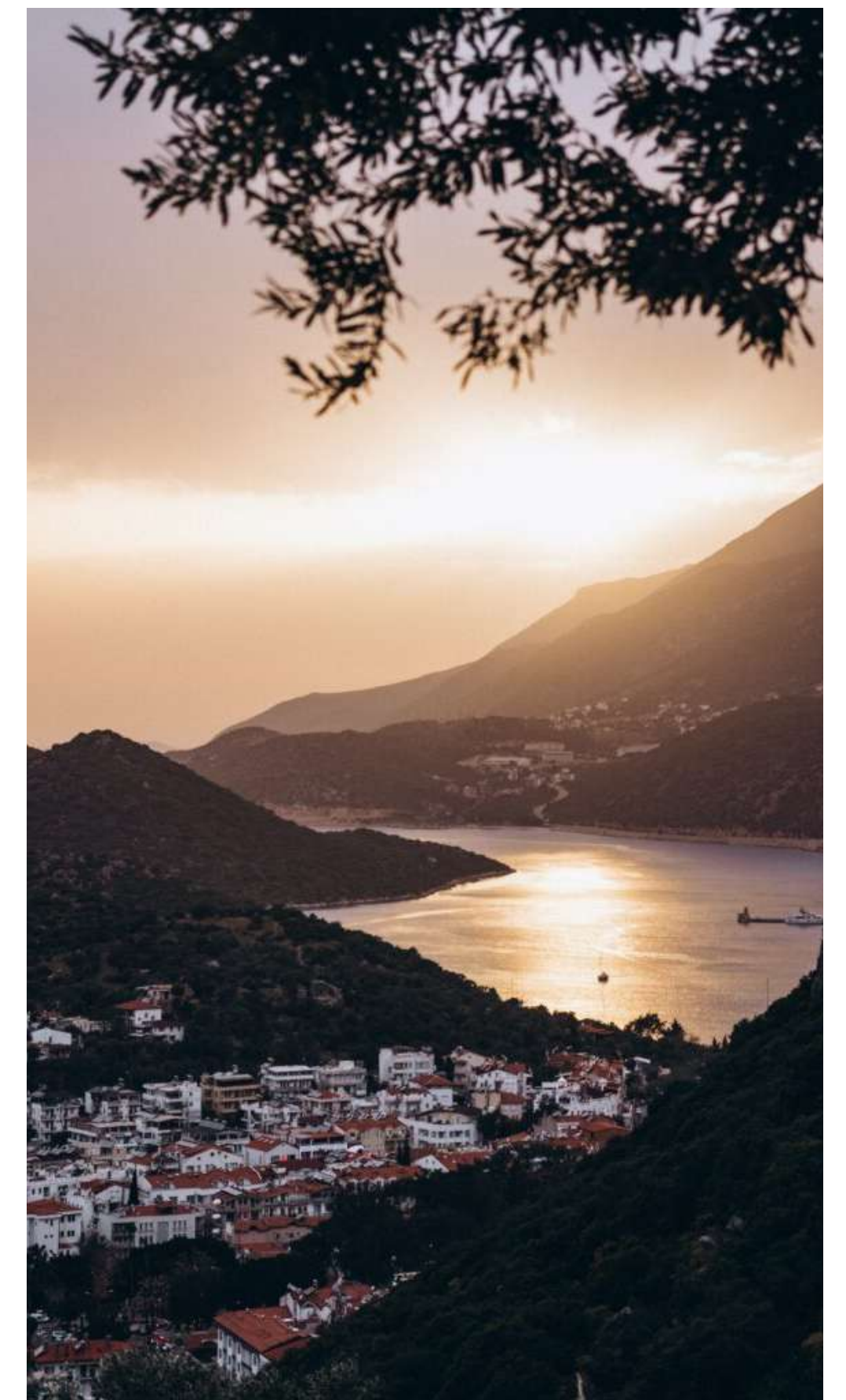
DAY 3 | KAS

Explore the charming village of Kas.

In Kas, you can experience the wonders of forest, sea, history, and art, all at once. You will find here the calm and serenity of several natural areas. Kas is also the perfect location for outdoor activities such as sea kayaking, hiking, or mountain biking.

Not to forget some incredible dive sites with shallow cave dives, reefs, and wrecks thriving with fish species, loggerhead turtles, dolphins, and the occasional seal. East of Kas there is the sunken Aperlai Ancient City, where semi-submerged tombs are surrounded by beautiful jade forests.

At night, the village comes to life with several excellent restaurants and lively bars that are open late into the night. Enjoy some cocktails onboard and head to one of the local taverns for dinner.



KEKOVA ISLAND

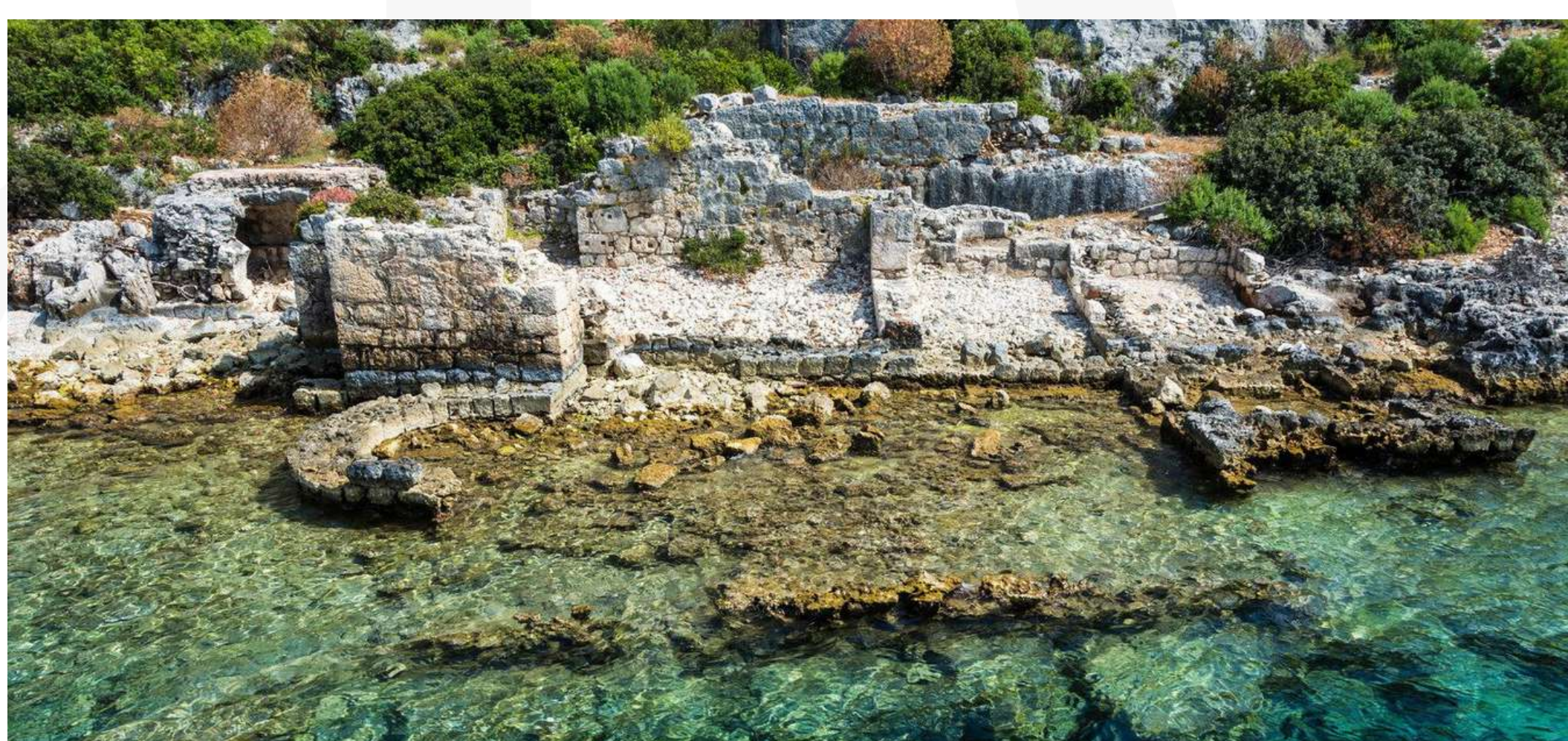
DAY 4

Visit the historic and vibrant island of Kekova.

As you cruise along the island's shore, you can look down through the crystal clear water at the ruins of houses and other buildings of the Byzantine city that ran along the coast.

Enjoy your lunch onboard and spend some time swimming and snorkeling.

Cruise to the picturesque village of Simena, a charming town that has remained unchanged for many years. Don't miss the castle that offers a magnificent view of the Kekova area.



DAY 5 | KALKAN



After breakfast, cruise to the charming fishing village of Kalkan. Enjoy a relaxing swim in the turquoise waters and benefit from water toys available onboard. There are some amazing dive sites in the area, including the shallow Firnaz Bay for beginners and Blue Cave and the Wreck of the Duchess of York, sunk in 1943 for experienced divers.



Stop for lunch at one of the local restaurants in Kalkan that offers delicious local dishes. You will also find here many boutiques selling authentic handmade clothes, furniture, and jewelry.

SARSALA

DAY 6



Take an opportunity to relax and chill in the bay of Sarsala. Numerous pine trees create a picturesque setting for your day of swimming and kayaking. You can also hike to the ancient city of Lissa, renowned for its ancient tombs carved into rock faces overlooking Lake Koycegiz. In the evening, your captain will take you to a secluded beautiful spot where you will have a romantic dinner prepared by your private Chef.

DAY 7 | GOCEK

Enjoy a late breakfast onboard and head back to Gocek enjoying the water toys and making swim stops in the most beautiful spots on your way.



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
