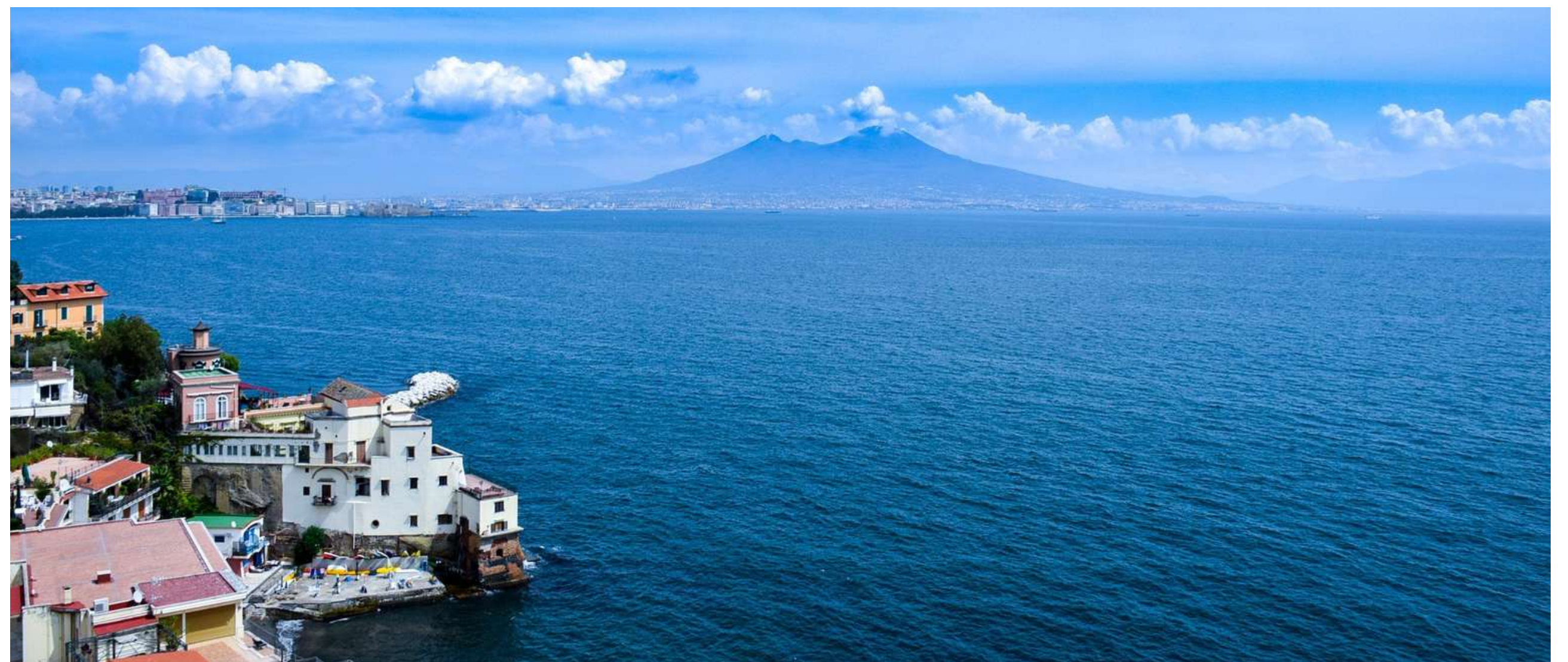

CAPRI | DAY 2 - 3



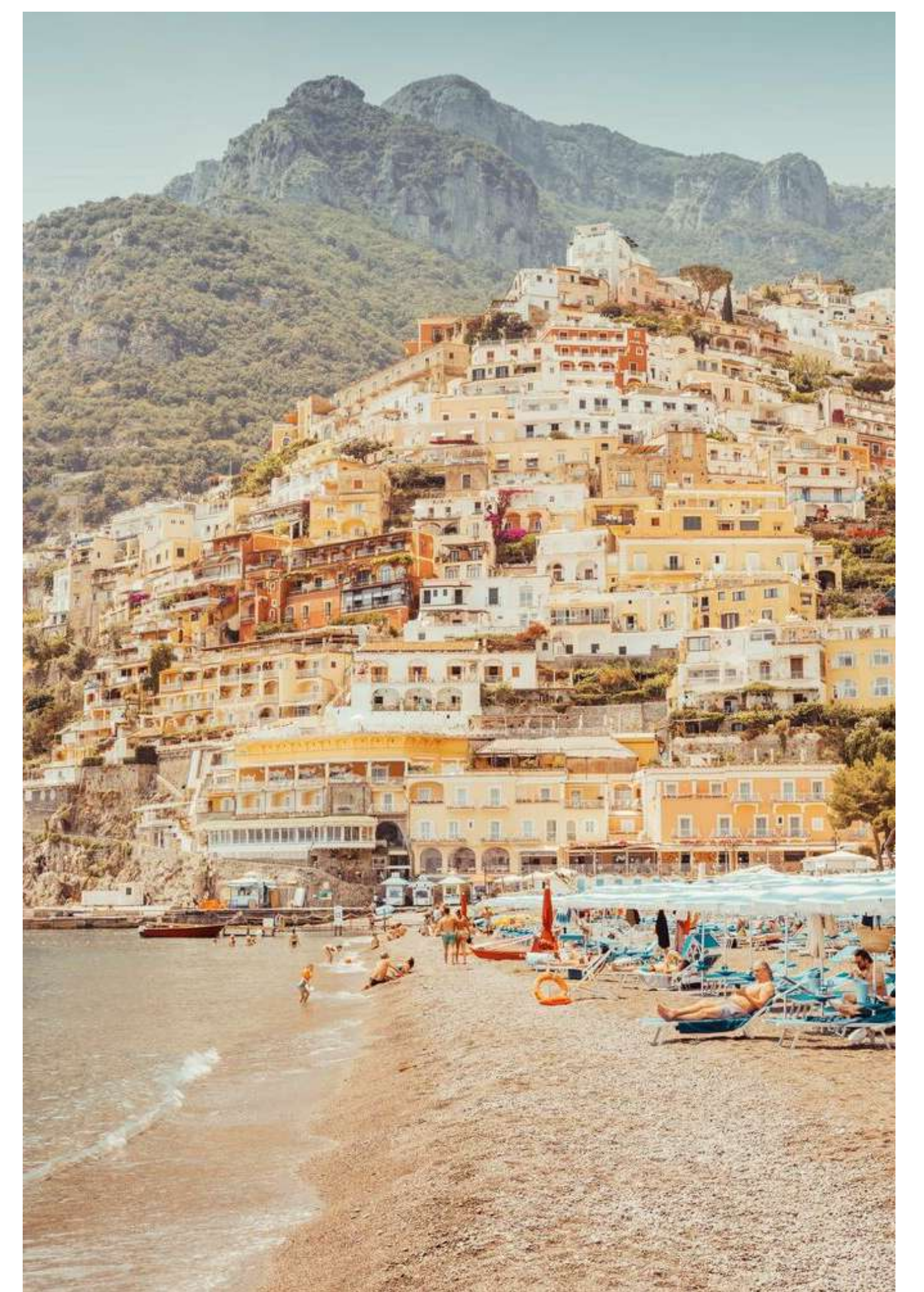

Take time to discover the Arco Naturale, the Faraglioni rocks, and the bay of Marina Piccola.

DAY 4 | POSITANO

Sail to Positano – the colorful legendary village that clings to the steep cliffside. This is probably the only place in the world where the panoramic view of the town is more beautiful than the seascape behind you.

Stop for a swim in the refreshing waters of the bay, or venture out to the mystical island of Sirenusius to uncover the myths and legends of Italy's past. After lunch, explore the enchanting streets of Positano and marvel at the stunning Santa Maria Assunta church, famous for its picturesque tiled dome. DAY 5



After breakfast, head towards the most remote islands of Italy's Pontine archipelago.

Discover Palmarola – a secret paradise in the Mediterranean. This uninhabited tiny isle surrounded by transparent blue waters, will mesmerize you with its handsome coastline, grottoes, and cliffs. It's a wonderful area for swimming, snorkeling, and exploring caves.

This tiny island is also home to a fantastic restaurant which can be found in one of only two buildings found there.

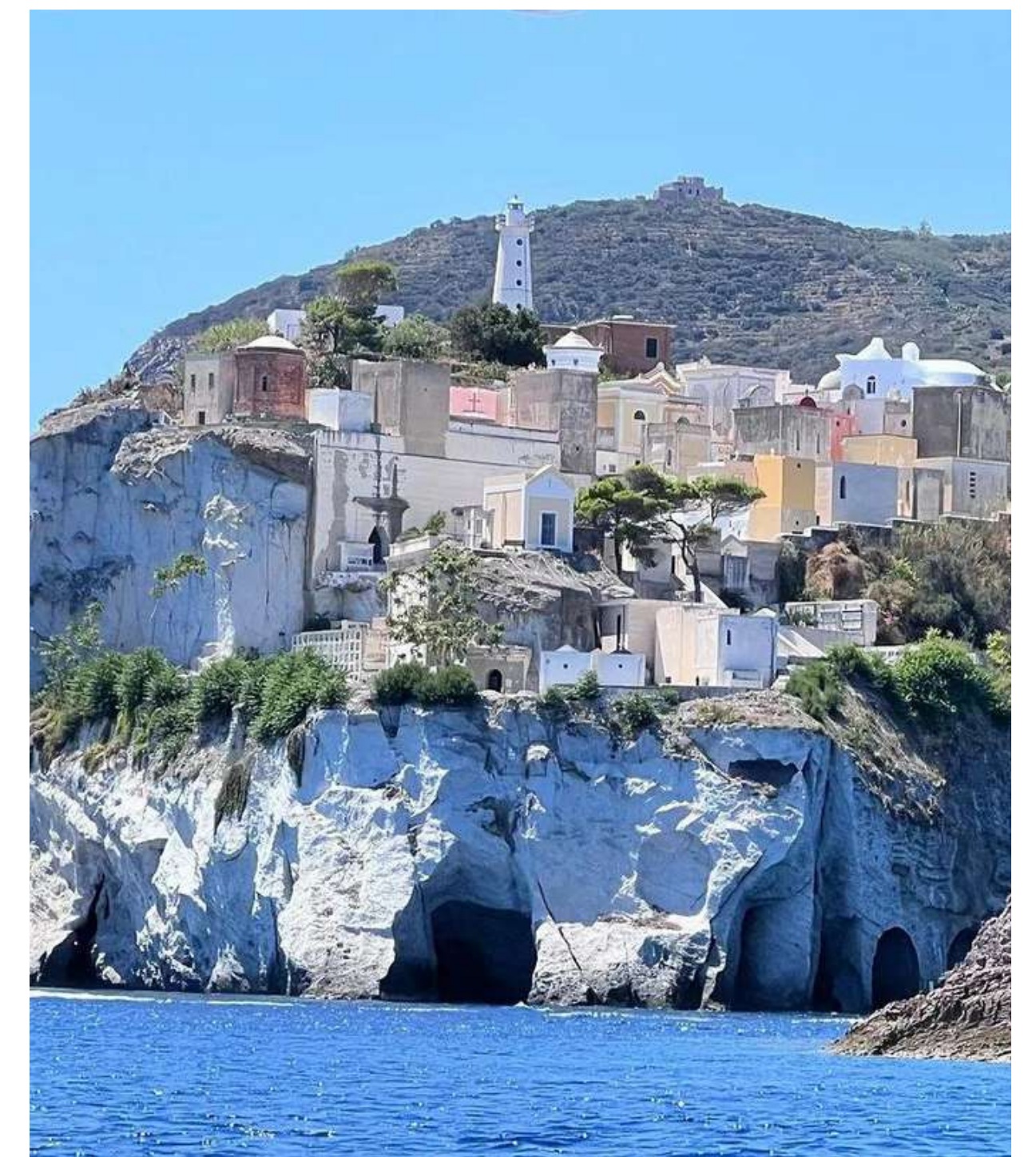
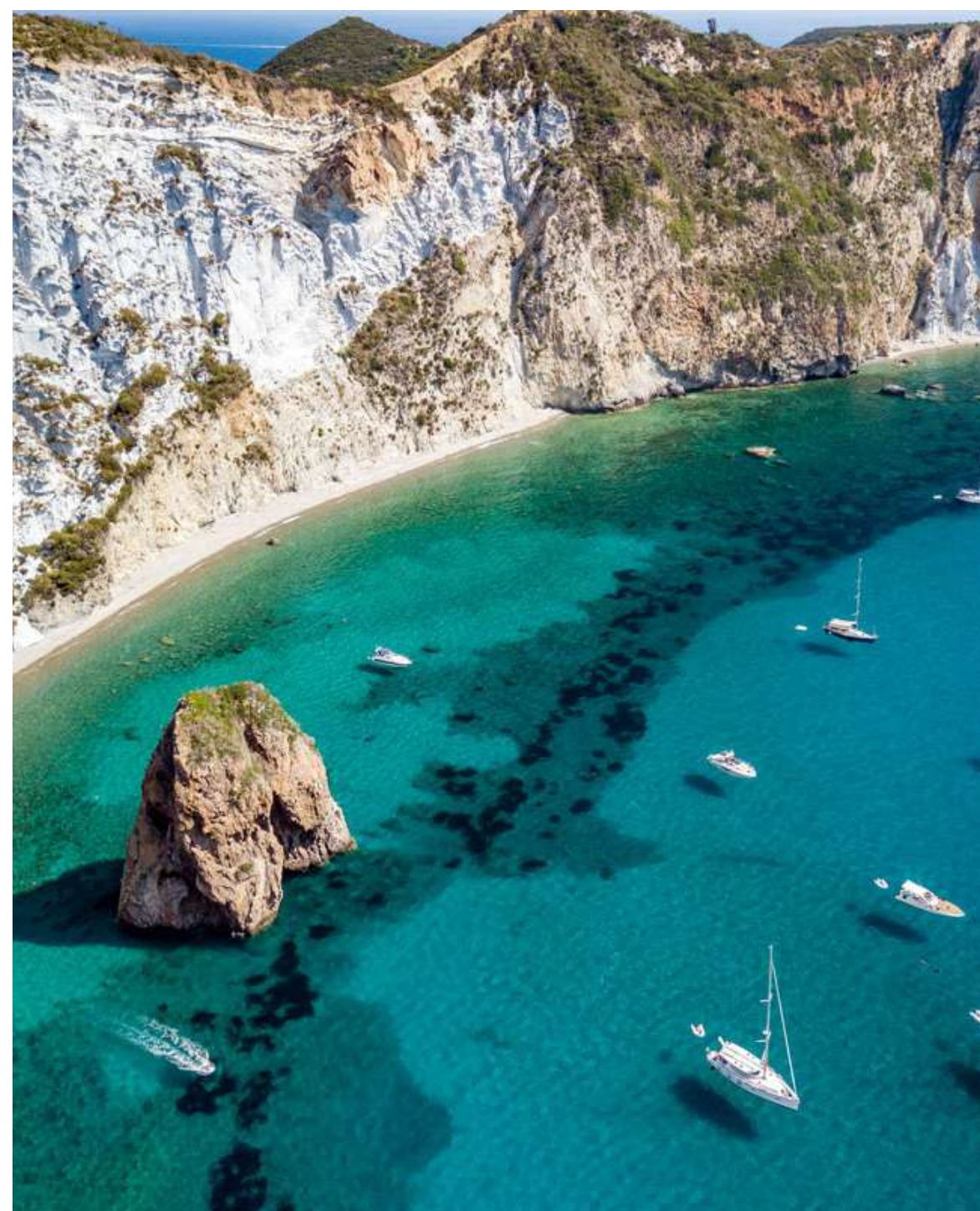


DAY 6 | PONZA

Cruise to Ponza, the largest of the Pontine island and one more well-kept Italian secret. Ponza boasts wonderful swimming and snorkeling opportunities from private beaches hidden between striking white cliffs.

Ponza is a volcanic outcrop that has been inhabited since Neolithic times. It has many archaeological ruins, primarily Etruscan and Roman, along with blue grottoes and charming streets with colorful houses.

Take your time to discover Ponza with its lively atmosphere, some excellent restaurants, and late-night drinking and dancing.
