DAY 1 | BONIFACIO



Meet your yacht in Bonifacio (Corsica) and after a welcome lunch onboard, take a chance to explore Bonifacio's beauties. Nestled in the southernmost expanse of Corsica, Bonifacio is a veritable jewel surrounded by turquoise waters.

A town of extraordinary beauty, Bonifacio is a true open-air museum with its distinctive character. In all seasons, it offers a unique collection of historic monuments, more than 20 fine-sandy beaches, and an exceptional collection of rare countryside both on land and at sea.

You can take a hike on a trail carved into the cliff for outstanding views out to the sea or prefer to stay cool and visit the historical monuments located in town.

LAVEZZI ISLANDS

DAY 2

Cruise to Lavezzi islands where the yacht will anchor for the day. Here you can enjoy swimming, snorkeling, and gazing at the picturesque Lavezzi islands.

These Islands are a natural reserve. Being one of the two Corsican marine reserves, Lavezzi islands are bathed in a turquoise and emerald sea, whose color varies according to the light.

Once in the water, the transparency is really surprising, probably the clearest water in Corsica. The beaches are numerous and truly magnificent. This is the ideal place to spend a lazy day enjoying the Mediterranean sun.

Step ashore for dinner in the restaurant of the Hotel des Pecheurs on Cavallo Island and try the local cuisine.



DAY 3 | ROCCAPINA



Sail to Roccapina, known for its stunning beach. If you are eager to have your own corner of paradise, you will find it here.

This beach is located in a protected area of south-west Corsica known as the Grand Valinco region. It's a region famous for its many prehistoric sites and ancient castles (casteddi), but also for the natural beauty of its lush vegetation.

So don't miss a chance to hike a bit for some fantastic views.

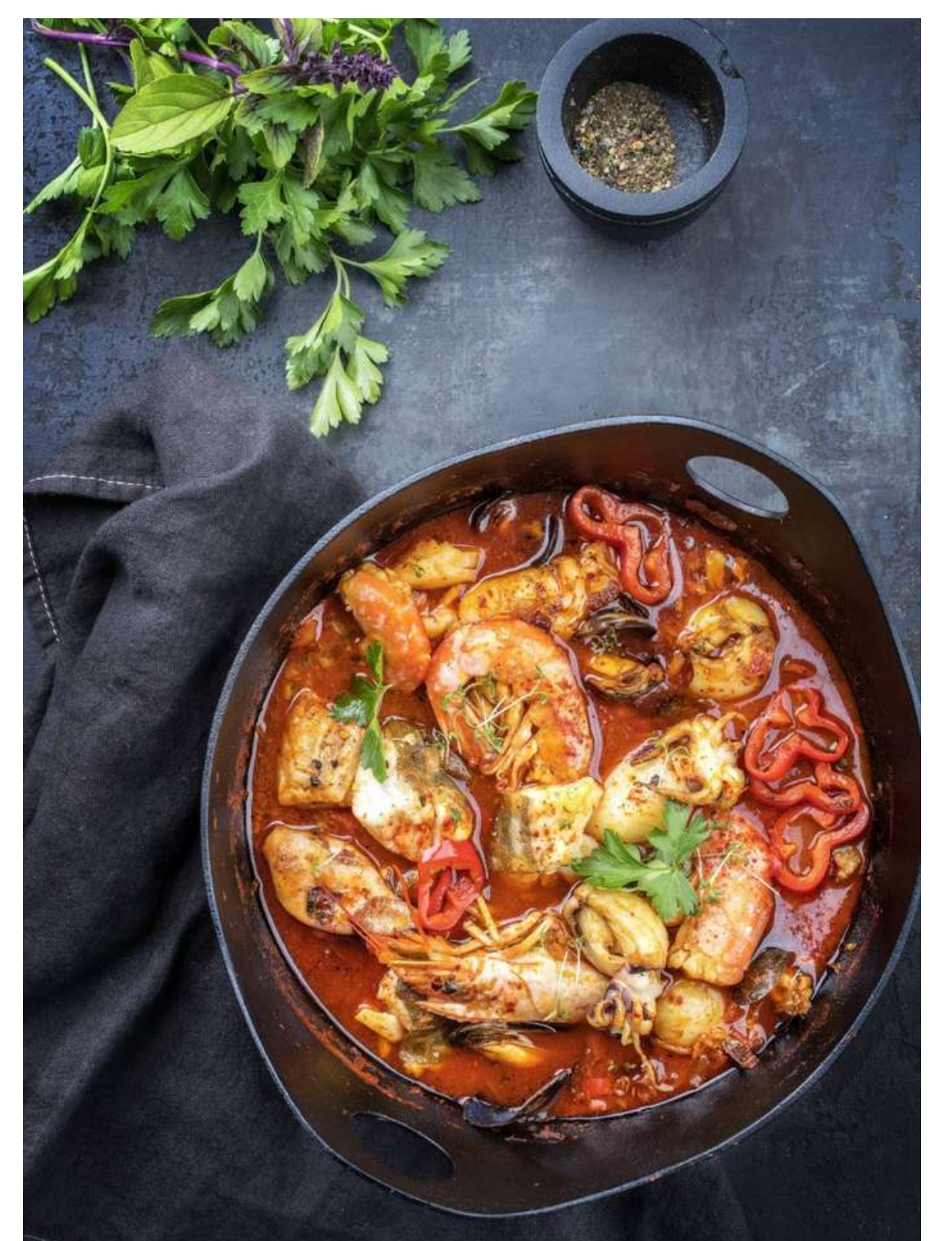
Dinner will be served onboard - your private Chef will surprise you with his signature dishes cooked from fresh local products.

LA MADDALENA
ISLANDS

DAY 4 - 5

After breakfast onboard, depart for Maddalena Islands, said to be one of the most beautiful cruising destinations in the Mediterranean. There is nothing quite like the tranquility of the Maddalena islands. These uninhabited, secluded islands are intersected by sparkling blue lagoons, sandy beaches, and transparent waters.

You will be mesmerized by pink-sand beaches, blue-green waters, and cliffs rising from the sea. It is also a perfect spot for scuba diving and snorkeling. Enjoy a lunch onboard and head to the town of La Maddalena with its charming streets and authentic Mediterranean flair.



DAY 6

CALA LUNA



Gathered between rocks overhanging the sea and granite boulders plunging into the clear turquoise water, it offers an unforgettable view. On the beach, there are large caves offering refreshing shelter in summer.

Enjoy a delicious lunch on the deck overlooking this gorgeous spot.

Sail to Cala Luna to explore the quiet and stunning side of Sardinia. This is a perfect anchorage with various caves where you can swim and explore.

Cala Luna boasts one of the most evocative beaches in the entire Gulf of Orosei with a beautiful crystal-clear sea.

The beach at Cala Luna is made of coarse white sand mixed with small pebbles, obviously white. Gathered between rocks overhanging the sea and granite boulders plunging into the clear turquoise water, it offers an unforgettable view.



PORTO CERVO

DAY 7 - 8



Cruise to Porto Cervo – the preferred location of jet setters and superyachts.

Porto Cervo is one of Gallura's most prestigious tourist areas and the main starting point for yacht charter in Sardinia. Porto Cervo is a charming village of multicolored houses, built on the edge of a natural harbor and surrounded by hills. The marina is surrounded by high-end restaurants, bars, and shops.
