DAY 1 | BALI

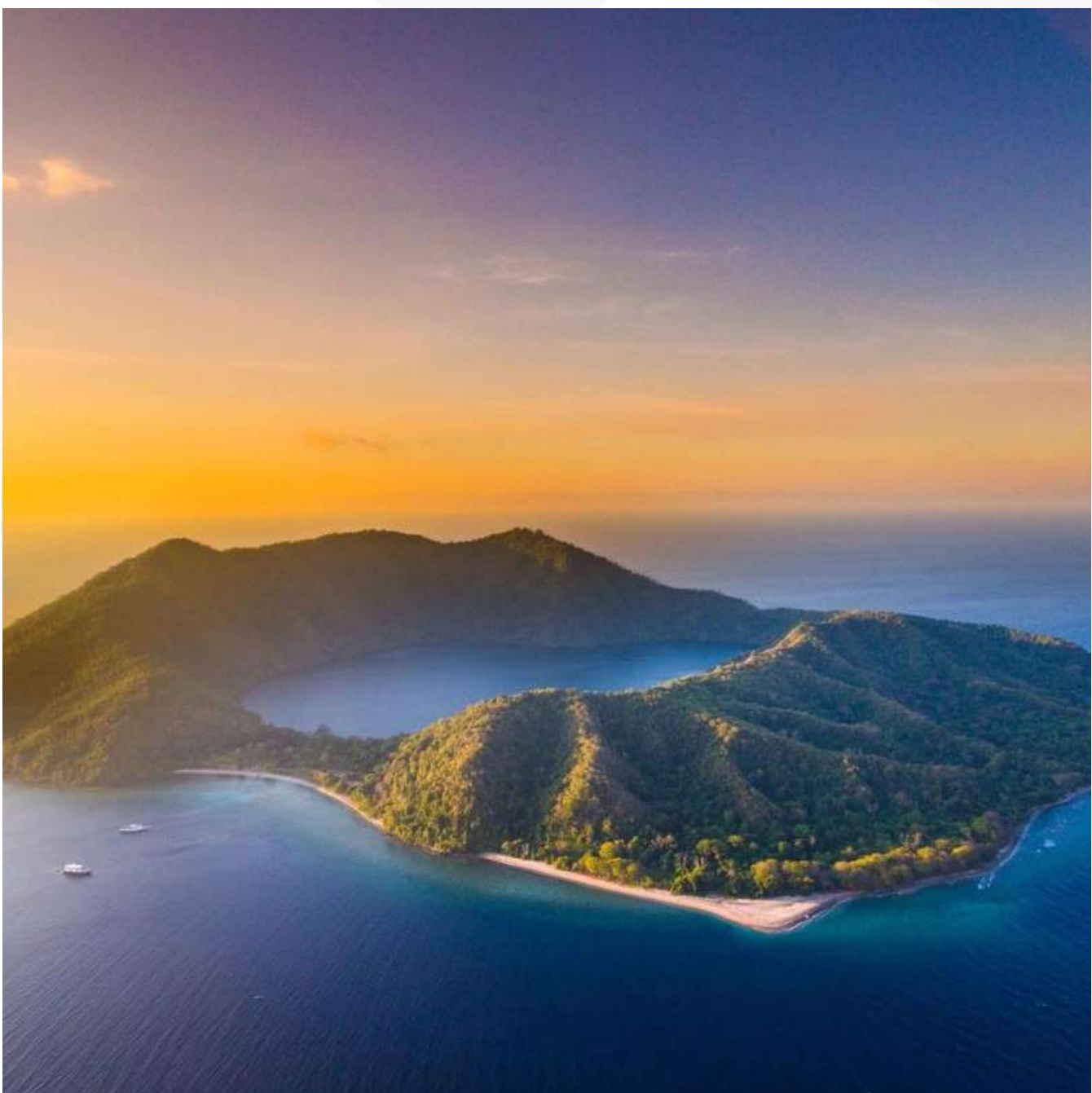


Embark your yacht in Bali -one of the most popular islands, known for stunning beaches, historic temples, and a striking landscape.
Cruise to your first port of call: The Gili Islands. Gili Islands are small islands, situated close to the north-west coast of Bali’s neighboring island, Lombok. Explore one of the luscious beaches and in the afternoon, dive into pristine waters where you may see turtles.

DAY 2



Cruise to Moyo island.
The national park island of Moyo Island is probably the most rewarding destination in Sumbawa, surrounded by beautiful coral reefs and home to wild pigs, monitor lizards, 21 species of bat, huge herds of native deers, and hordes of crab-eating macaques.
Admire stunning waterfalls hidden in the depths of the trees on your way into Satonda, a crater lake that emerged during the 1815 volcanic eruption.



DAY 3

SANGEANG
GILI BANTA

Sangeang is one of the locations you are likely to never forget. It's a rare opportunity to dive into the waters of a live volcano or visit the local Mera village to see traditional boat-building methods still used by the natives.

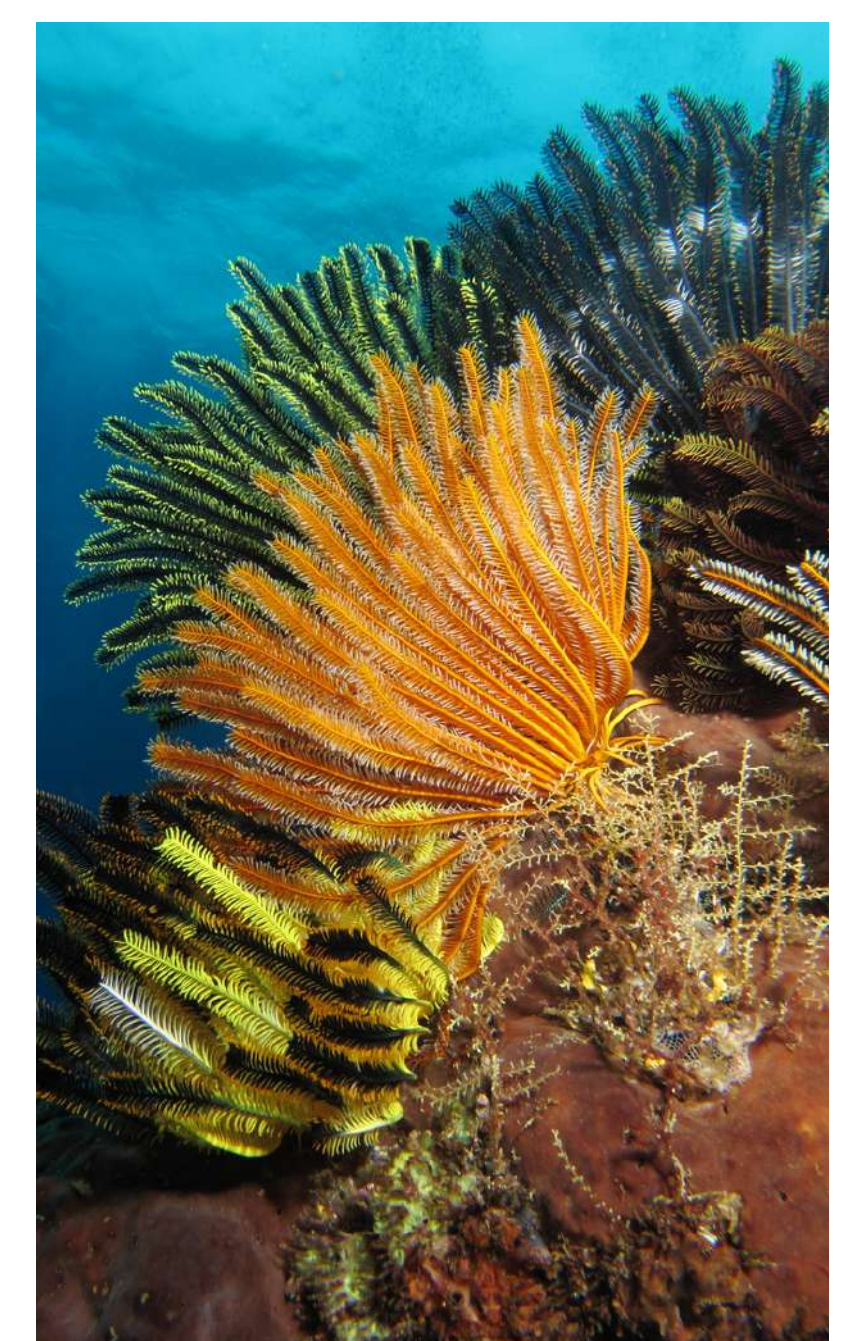
Then head to Gili Banta, the uninhabited island, a true paradise with divine beaches, the perfect spot for a relaxed walk on the long white sand beach or water sports in a sheltered bay (jet skiing is allowed in this area).

In the evening enjoy a romantic barbeque on the beach set up by your crew.

DAY 4

After breakfast, sail to the northernmost part of Komodo National Park. Here you will swim with fish of varying species including trevally, groupers, sweetlips, barracudas, and white-tip reef sharks. Enjoy a light lunch onboard and take a hike to a spectacular viewpoint from where we can see Lamima anchored in the bay below.

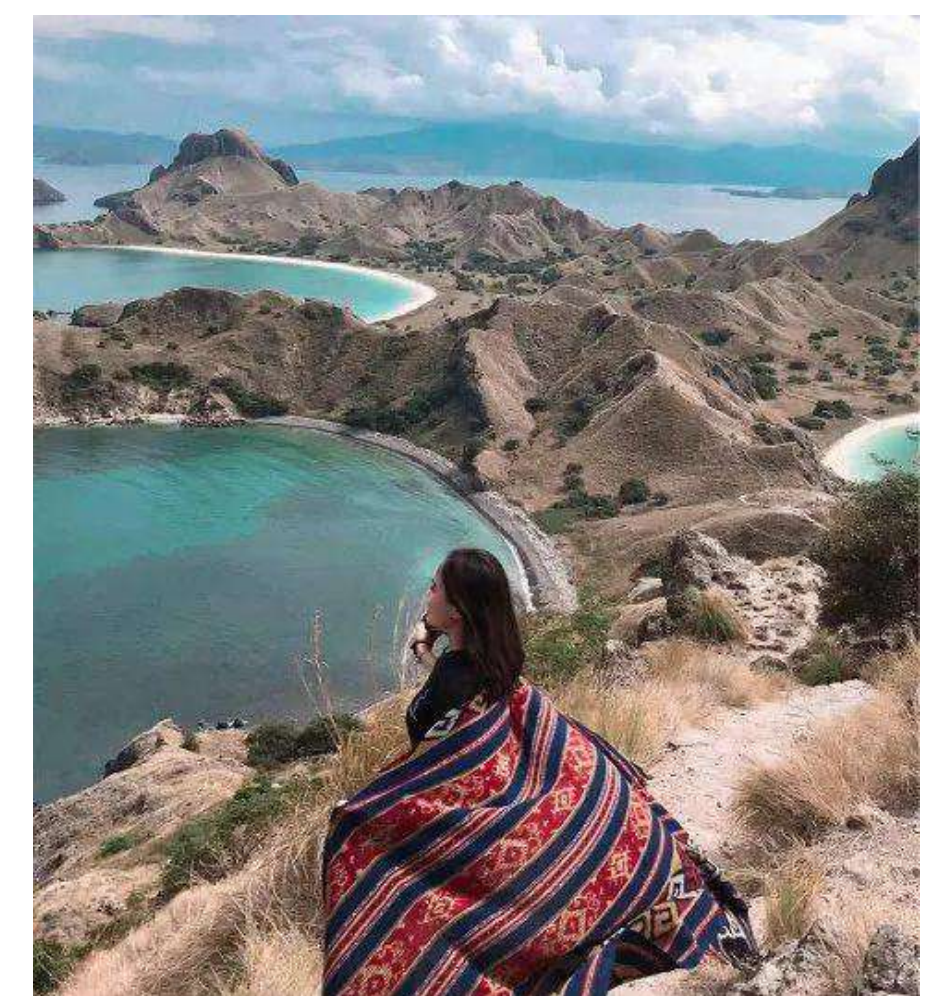


DAY 5 - 6

PULAU PADAR
CENTRAL KOMODO

Time to anchor down in the bay of Padar.

Padar is a beautiful island with spectacular scenery and a great place to see the legendary pink sand that's unique to this area. You will have 2 days of endless diving opportunities waiting for you. Pretty coral displays and other underwater quirks make diving here exciting and unforgettable. The next stop is Komodo Island - a national park with protected waters. Take the plunge into several different areas around the coastline to see different angles of staggering natural beauty. Enjoy water sports equipment available onboard: you can either speed around on a jet ski or take your time with a taste of windsurfing.



SOUTH RINCA

DAY 7



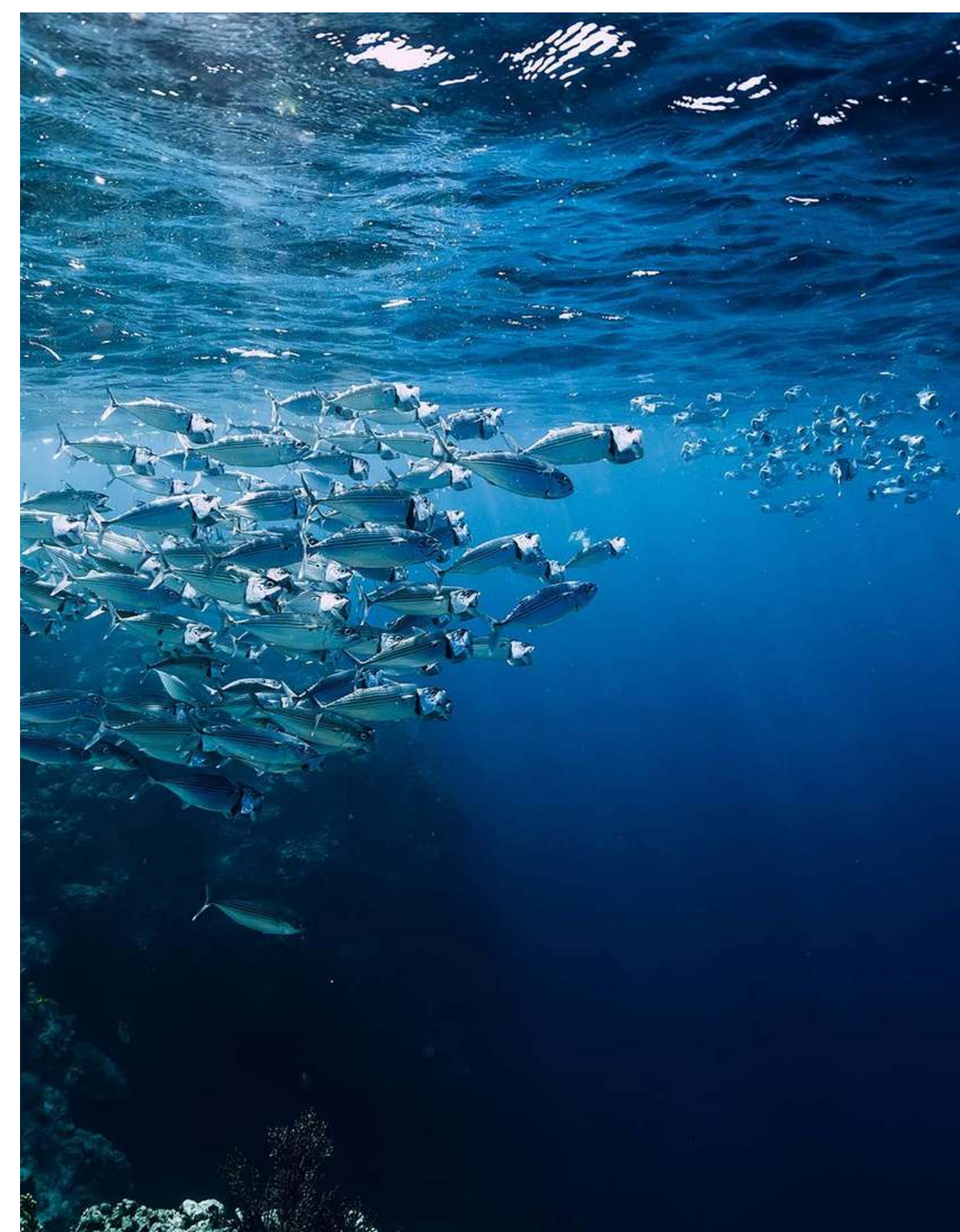
Cruise to Rinca is one of the main islands in the Komodo archipelago with idyllic waters. Moving on to South Rinca, one of the region's best dive sites. Here, you will get to experience the best of what Komodo National Park has to offer. Swim with nudibranchs, turtles, sea snakes, and frogfish amongst some of the most colorful coral in Indonesia. After lunch, head ashore where you will be able to see the world's largest living lizard, the Komodo Dragon.



DAY 8 | KOMODO STRAIT

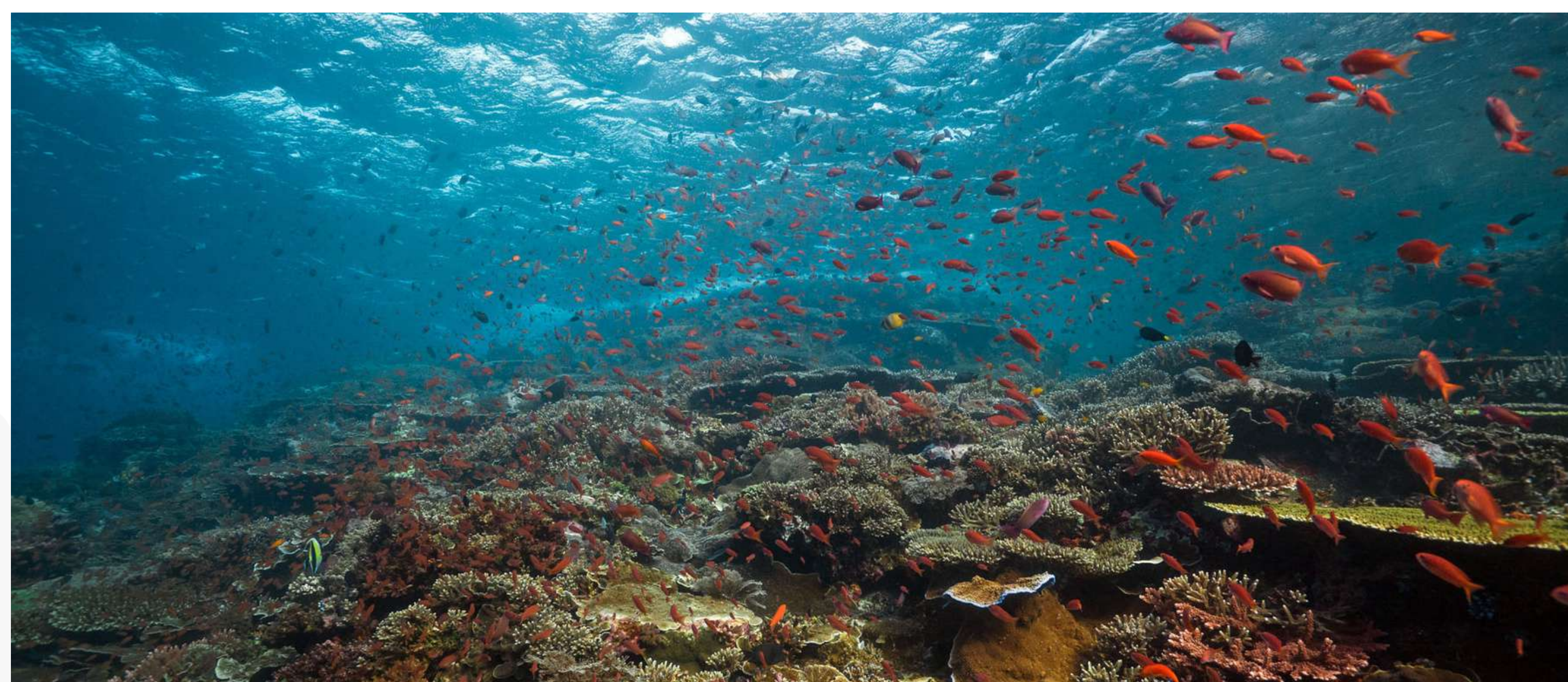
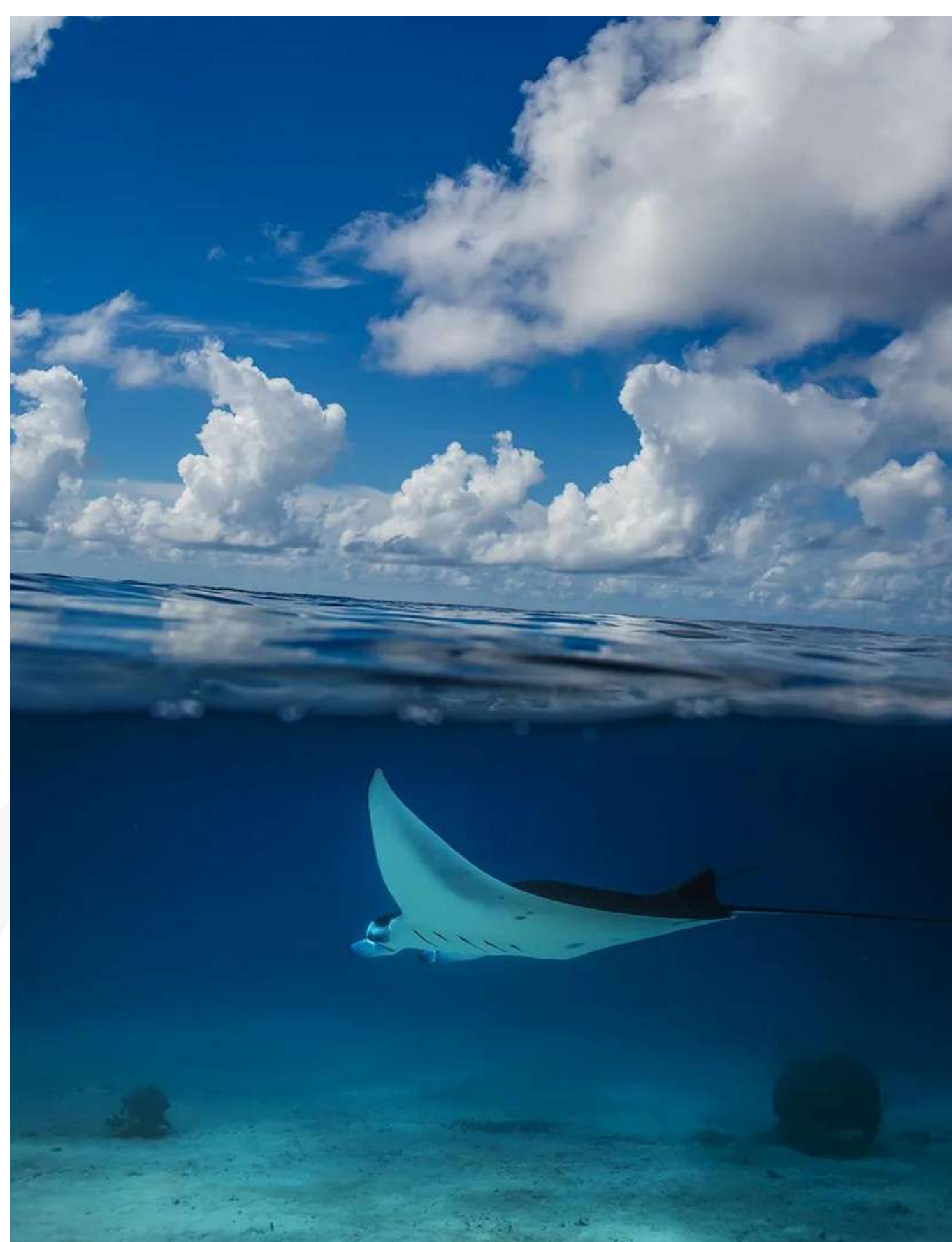
Nestled between the islands of Komodo and Rinca, the Komodo Strait is home to even more stunning diving sites vibrant with colors. The most attractive diving locations in the area are the Tarawa Besar and Kecil Dives.
