DAY 2



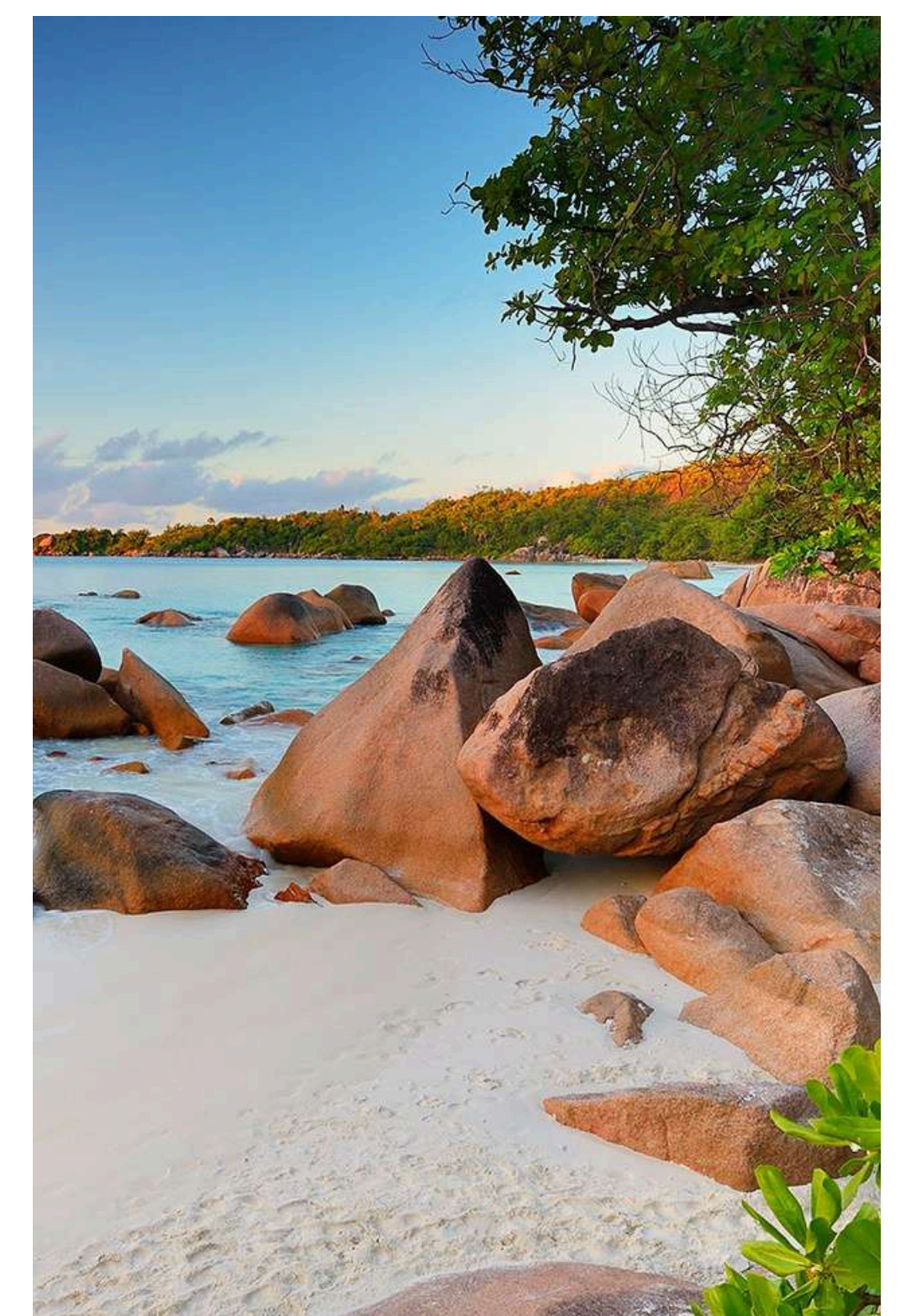
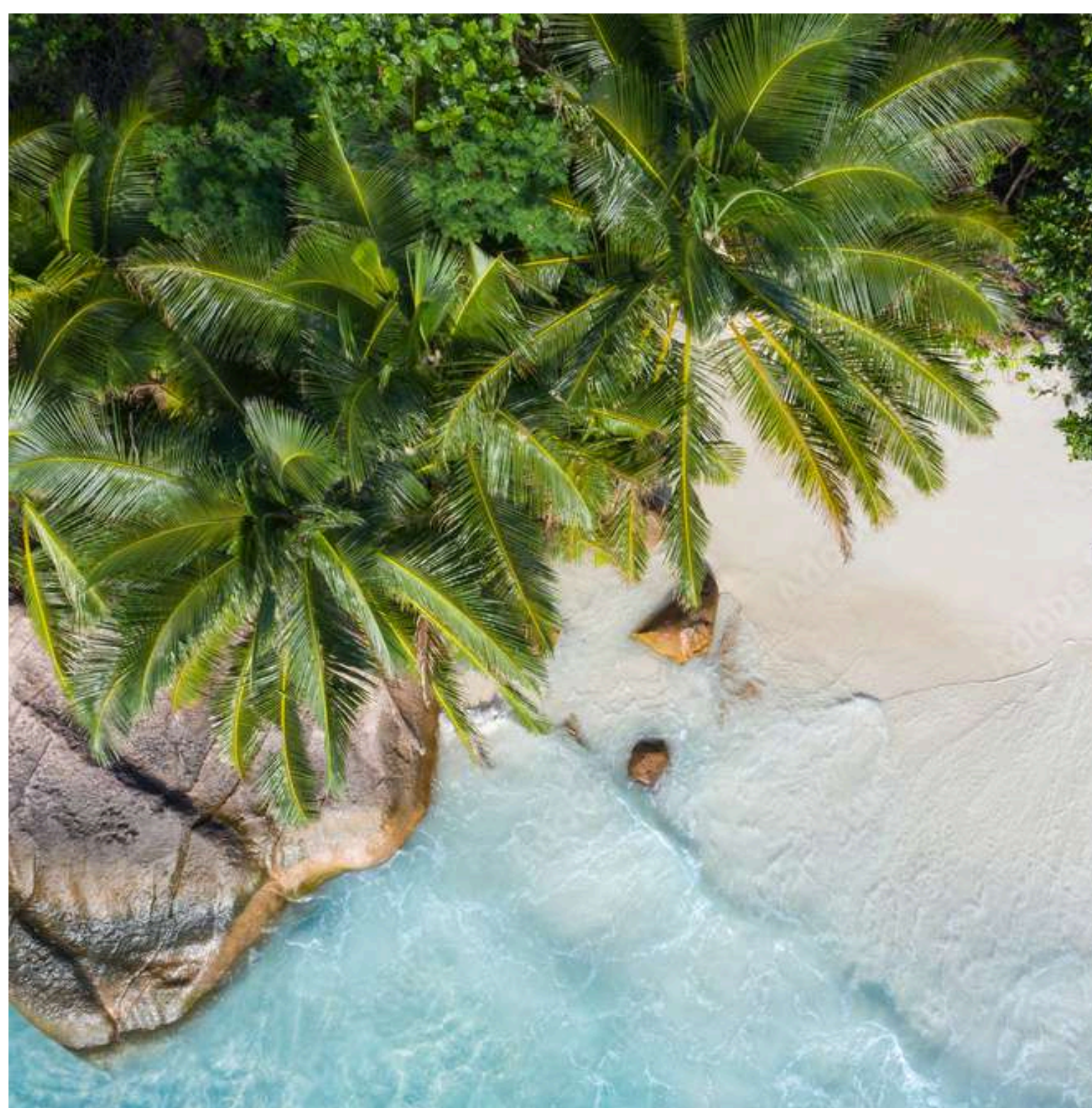

DAY 3 | PRASLIN (ANSE LAZIO)

The incredible combination of turquoise blue water and fine sand, picturesque palm trees, and impressive granite rocks make Anse Lazio one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. This postcard beach offers options for everyone, whether it's swimming, snorkeling, sunbathing or photography.

LA DIGUE

DAY 4



La Digue is a true paradise. This beautiful island located 6 km south-east of Praslin is reached by boat in 15 minutes.

Its proportions are modest (5 km long by 3 km wide), but they present all the beauties of the Seychelles archipelago. Stop to visit one of the vanilla plantations on the island. Vanilla is one of the island's main exports and gives the area a delightful scent.

Have lunch at one of the family-run restaurants and check out local shops where you can find some authentic unique pieces.

Spend the rest of the day swimming and indulging yourself with delicious cocktails and meals onboard.



DAY 5 | DESROCHES

Cruise to the pretty island of Desroches, whose coast is adorned with beautiful corals. Take time to dive and explore these stunning reefs.

Watch the hundreds of fish flitting in and out of the formations and keep your eyes peeled for larger visitors like rays and reef sharks.



SAINT JOSEPH

DAY 6



Have breakfast onboard and sail to St Joseph. Mainly uninhabited, this island is an incredibly peaceful place.

Take an opportunity to dive in the lagoon to see the abundance of marine life that lives here.

Finish your day with a beach barbeque set up by your crew to enjoy an unbeatable sunset over the Indian Ocean.
