DAY 1 | PHUKET

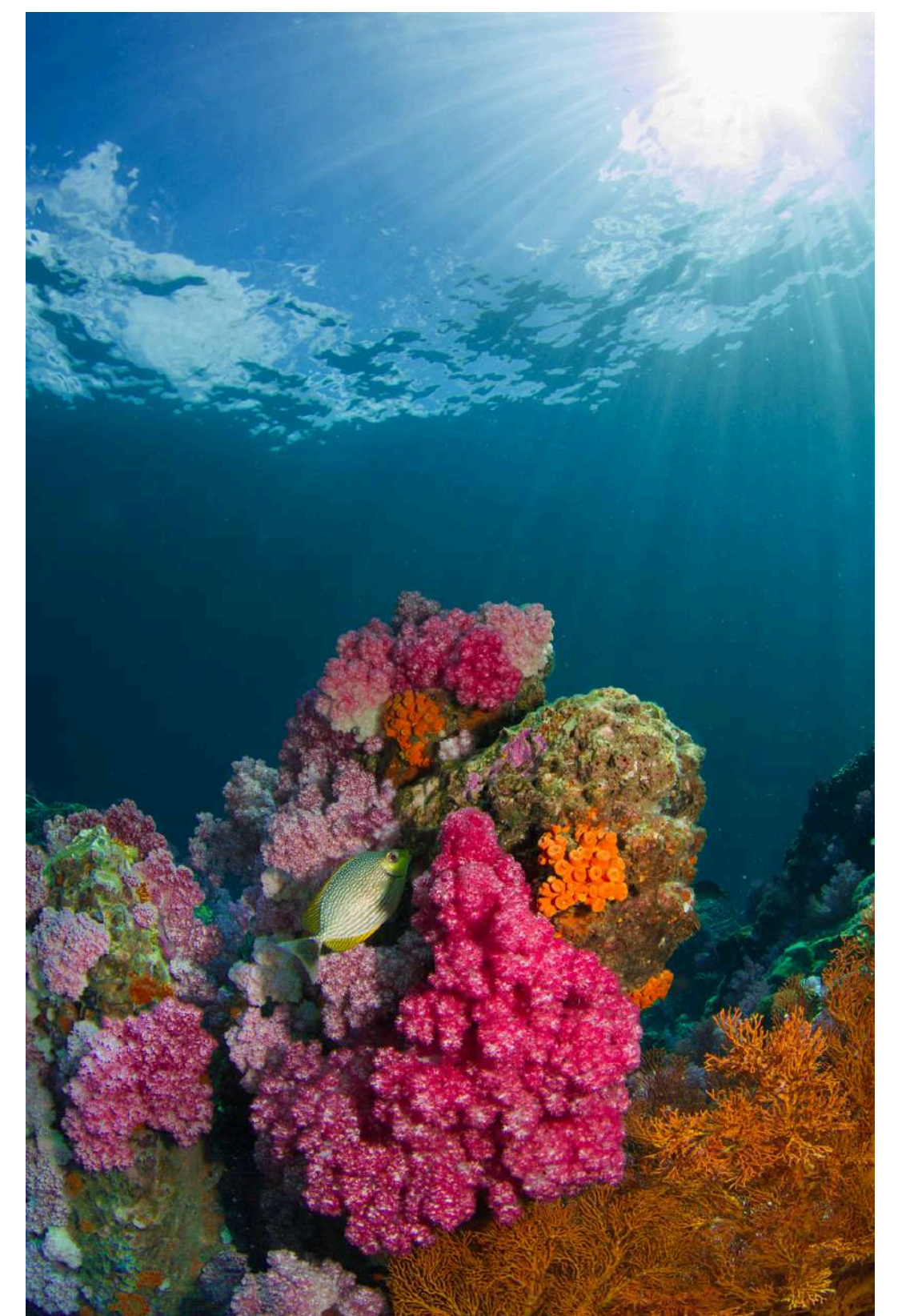
One of the most famous destinations in Thailand, Phuket has well-developed marinas and tourist facilities.

Spend some time visiting temples, shopping in local markets and boutiques, enjoying some pampering in the spas, or playing golf.

Cruise to the western side of the island which is filled with beautiful beaches where verdant mountains create private bays with cool transparent water.



Beginner Scuba divers can learn their skills among shallow dive sites such as Karon Beach, Crab Island, and Ko Lipe, offering colorful corals and numerous sea creatures just 10m below the surface. More advanced divers will appreciate the Coral Island and Mauritius Rock dive sites.

DAY 2

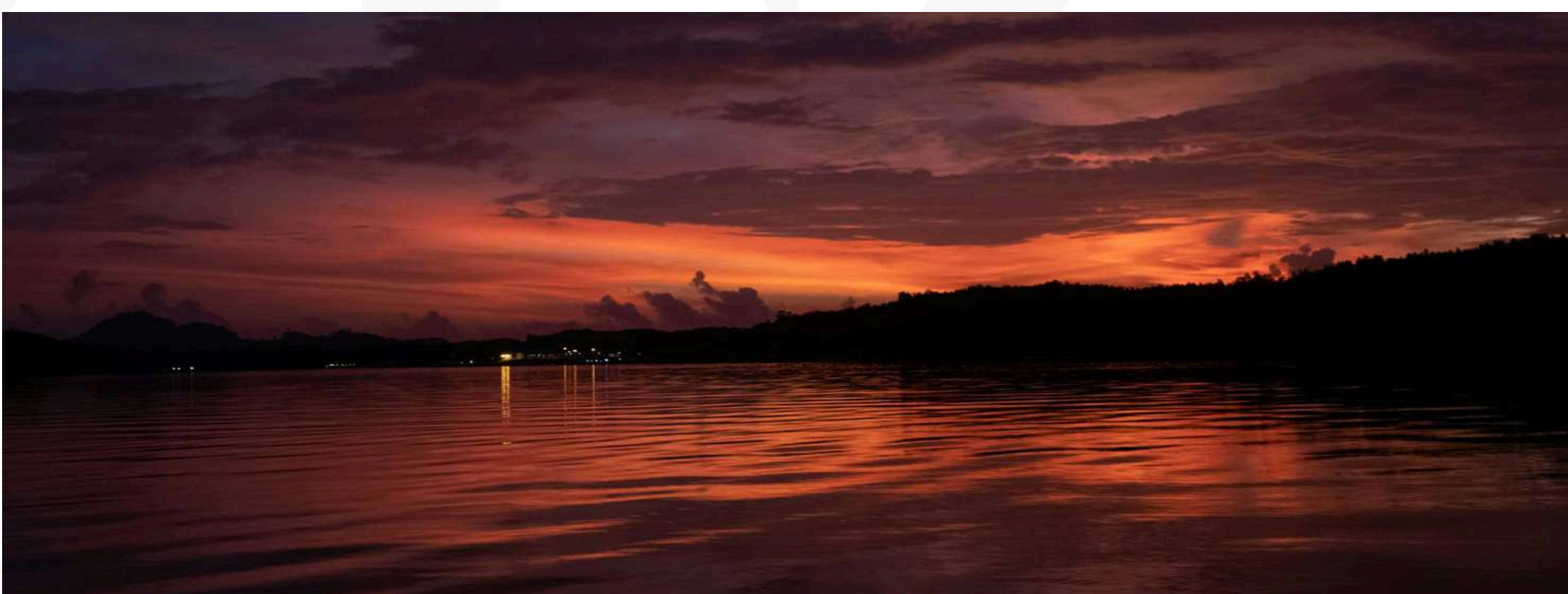


Cruise to Phang Nga Bay famous for its spectacular scenery with limestone cliffs rising out of green water, caves, lagoons, and tiny secluded beaches awaiting discovery.

This idyllic spot has 2 national parks -one in the north and another in the south, that give you a choice of beaches to chill and relax after hours of fun with the water toys.

The Than Bok Khorani National Park has some stunning caves with stalactites and stalagmites disappearing into the depths of the darkness.

Those looking to make a more sedate connection with nature can trek along forest paths filled with wildlife to discover serene waterfalls, snorkel along the coast among strange and colorful marine species such as clownfish and seahorses, or simply chill on the sundeck.



DAY 3 | KOH PHI

Reef sharks, zebra sharks, turtles, and barracuda are spotted in the waters surrounding Koh Phi, and the numerous snorkeling and scuba dive sites offer enough variety to satisfy even advanced divers: swim into Maya Cave or encounter reef sharks at Palong Wall and the Hin Phae, or be amazed by the stunning pink corals at Ko Yung.

Come back onboard to chill and enjoy a delicious dinner prepared by your private Chef.



KOH LANTA

DAY 4



Hike the western side of the peninsula and encounter beach bars and family-run restaurants along the way for an authentic dining experience, then rest up on one of the sandy crescents such as Ao Nui Bay Beach, Bamboo Beach, and the National Park Beach to the very south.



Cruise to Koh Lanta. Beautiful beaches, deep jungle, and magical sunsets make this island unique. Dedicate some time to stroll through Lanta Old Town with its historic atmosphere, and stunning colorful temples.

DAY 5 | KOH MUK

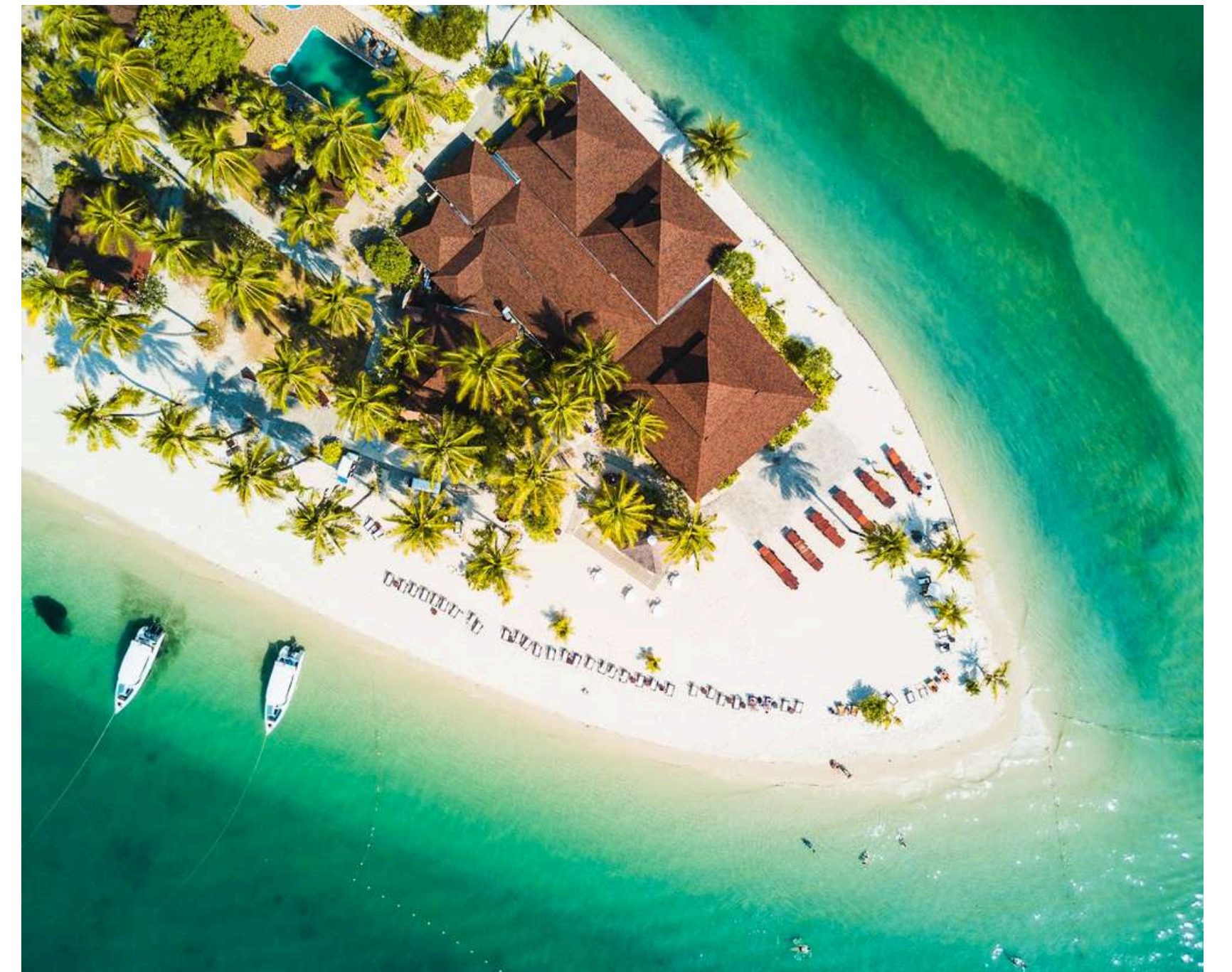


After breakfast onboard, sail to Koh Muk.

Jungle-covered Koh Muk is mostly untouched by its human inhabitants.

The breathtaking Emerald Cave and the snow-white Sivalai Beach, make Koh Muk one of the most spectacular islands in Thailand. The Cave is accessible only by swimming through a 70 m tunnel to an open chamber where the light tumbles through the open ceiling and reflects off the surface to dance on the cave walls in green hues.

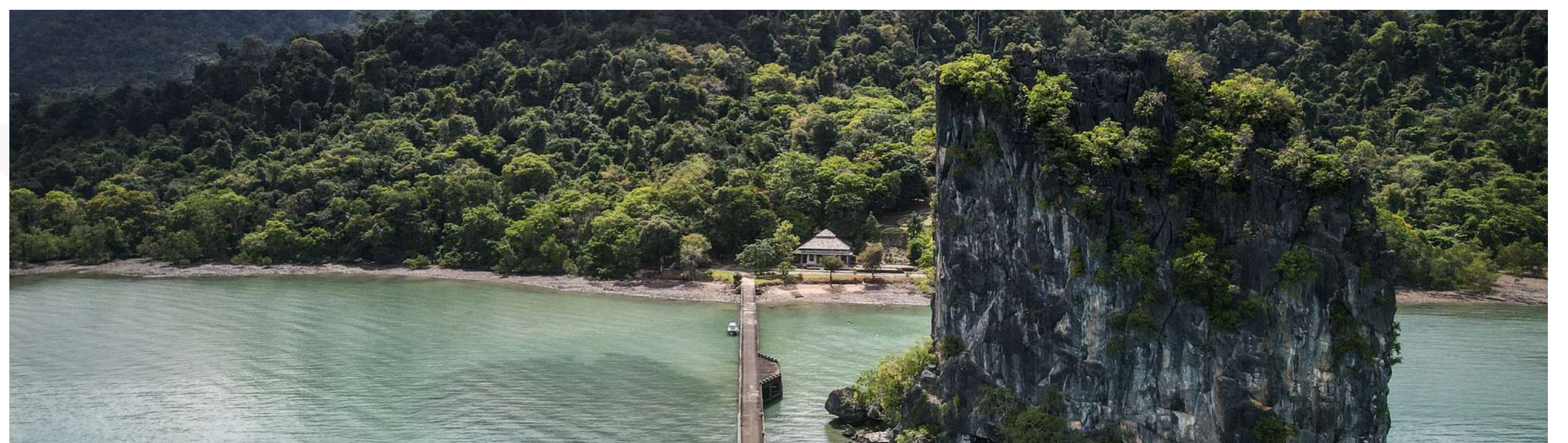
After lunch onboard, get on a kayak or paddleboard and observe fish swimming above the grassy meadows covering the sea floor.

DAY 6

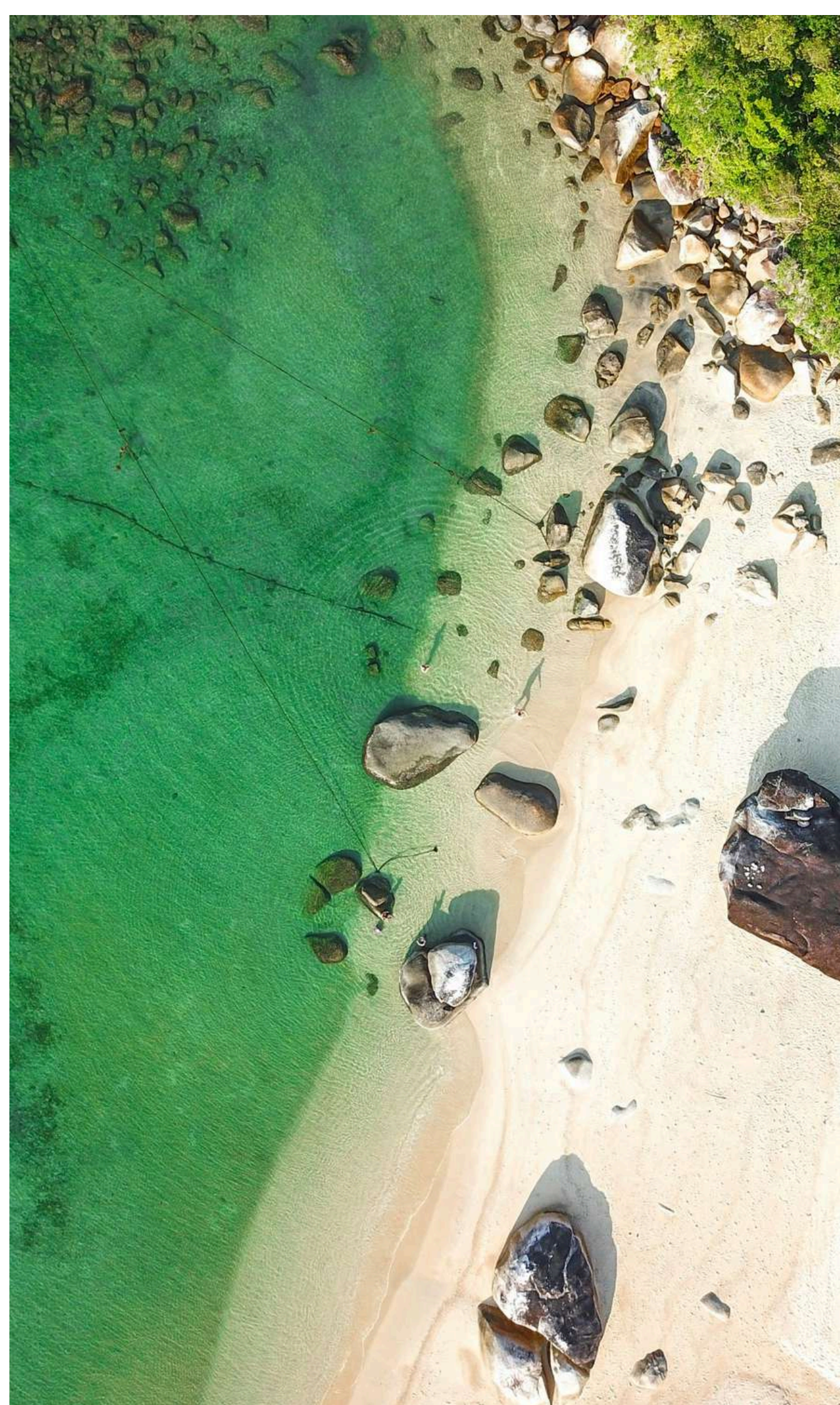
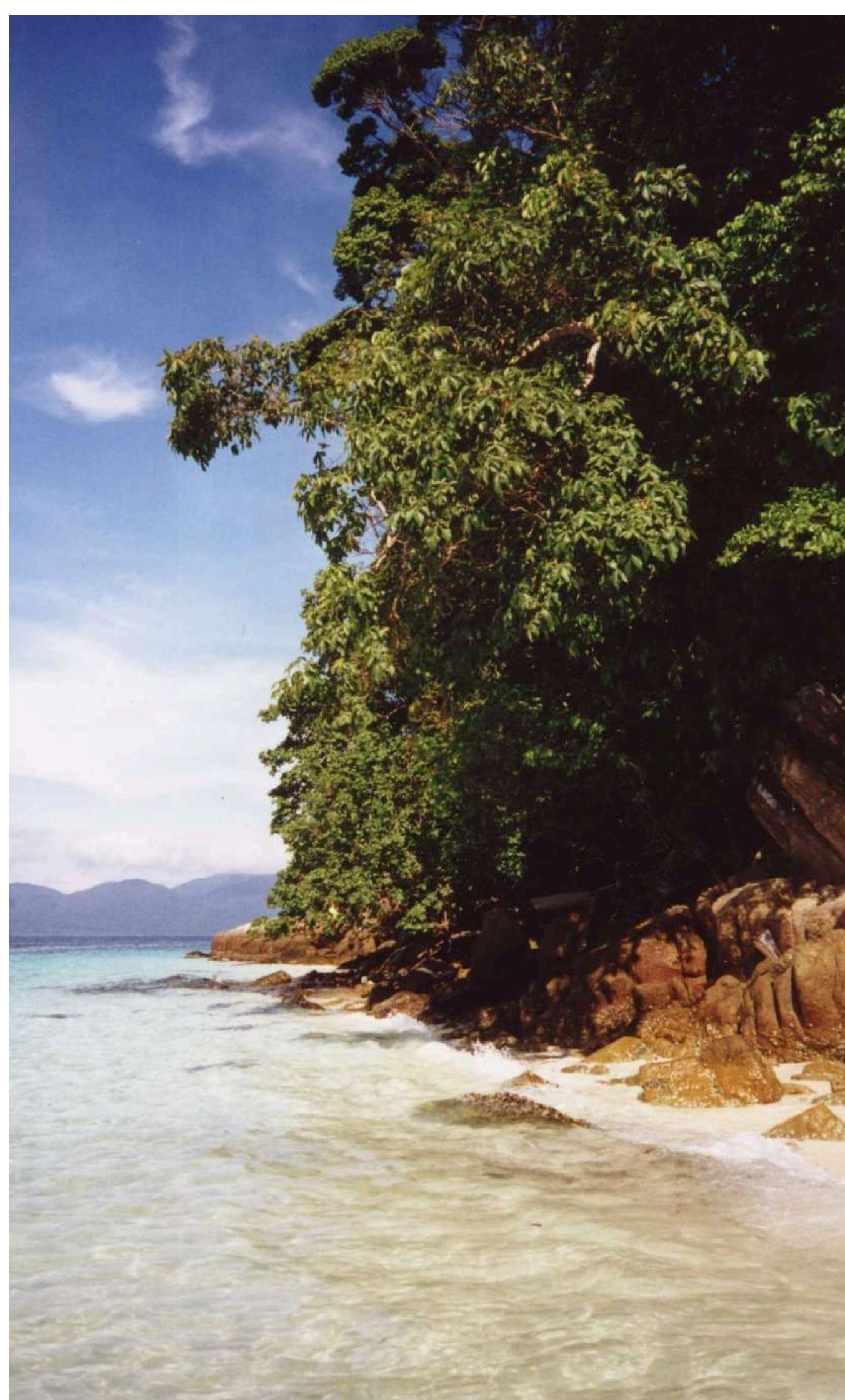
While cruising to the Butang Archipelago, enjoy your breakfast. You will soon reach your stunning destination consisting of more than 50 islands within the Tarutao National Marine Park, where lionfish, barracuda, grouper, clownfish, and seahorses can all be spotted.

Around 25% of the world's tropical fish species are to be found within the national park, which is replete with Scuba dive sites from beginner through to advanced.



DAY 7

KO TARUTAO



Cruise to Ko Tarutao, one of the most unspoiled and exquisite islands in the Andaman Sea and the seventh largest island in Thailand.

It is an amazing spot that allows you to fully enjoy tranquility and immerse in the sounds and sights of the tropics.

Ko Tarutao Marine National Park is replete with scenic views and plenty of fun activities that you and your family can participate in.

Head to Ao Son beach and hike to watch colorful birds and Lu Du Waterfall, or take the tender through a mangrove forest to the 300m deep Crocodile Cave, named after crocodiles now extinct on the island.

Come back onboard, soak in the Jacuzzi, and enjoy a dinner prepared by your Chef.

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
